The Vermont Recreation & Parks Association (VRPA) is pleased to announce its **15th Annual Vermont Performance Showcase on Thursday, November 15, 2018 from 9:00am-3:00pm** at Lake Morey Resort & Conference Center in Fairlee, VT.

This is an excellent opportunity for YOU to be included in a gathering of top-notch New England talent and to showcase your talents to an audience of people who hire performing artists for programs and special events in parks, schools, libraries, fairs & festivals, theaters, etc.

There will be 24 nine-minute performances throughout the day; each showcase artist will do one 9-minute showcase performance. Our showcase is organized around one stage with two separate performance areas. While one performer is showcasing, the next performer is setting up.

Each showcase artist will have an exhibit table. The room is large enough to host the stage and exhibit tables all in one room, so that you can be available to potential buyers and watch the performances at the same time. The artists always love this about our showcase. You have the option to register for an exhibit table without doing a performance too.

Each showcase artist will have a listing in the Showcase Program Booklet, which is available in hard copy at the showcase and also posted indefinitely on the VRPA website. For extra visibility, you can choose to pay a little extra and include your logo with your program listing or buy a half or full-page ad. We provide attendance incentives by giving away door prizes throughout the day...you can donate an item if you'd like. To encourage people to stay for the entire showcase, VRPA sponsors a \$100 gift certificate raffle after the last performance, good toward the booking of a show given by any performer listed in the program booklet and... you must be present to win. Year after year, almost everyone stays until the end.

Lake Morey is located just north of White River Junction and provides easy access along major highways from all directions for artists and the audience. Most of our audience will be coming from Vermont and New Hampshire. Lake Morey Resort also works well because you can stay right there the night before too.

In order to continue to attract showcase audience attendees, we strive to showcase a large number of new acts annually. Therefore, we reserve the right to be selective in choosing the artists to perform at the showcase. It is to your advantage to return your completed application and payment by the October 12th deadline! If you are not selected to perform, we encourage you to consider attending as an exhibitor. Many of our attendees come ready to make bookings on the spot and you will miss out if you are not there. In past years, folks have also organized a lot of block bookings at our showcase. If you are not selected to perform and choose not to attend as an exhibitor only, you will be given a full refund. **Confirmation of artist acceptance will be made by October 19th.**

Will you need electricity at your exhibit table?

Will you bring a door prize for the delegate raffle? *It can be a recording or something unrelated to your performance (such as a gift card). Thanks for considering.*

A description of any grant funding programs you are affiliated with that presenters can apply for when hiring you, for example New England States Touring (NEST), artists-in-residence or community arts grant from the Vermont Arts Council or another state arts council, etc. This will be included *in the showcase program booklet*.

A performance fee will be listed in the showcase program booklet. A dollar amount ranging from \$____ to \$____ must be included. Simply stating “negotiable” is not adequate.

A description of the services/programs you provide for the showcase booklet, limited to **85 words**. Anything more than **85 words** will be cut.

A brief description of your proposed 9-minute stage performance.

A description of your proposed performance setup including the # of people, equipment, # of vocals and # of microphones you will need. (A professional sound crew will be on hand with plenty of sound equipment, including wireless mics this year.) *You will only have 9 minutes to set up equipment for your performance. We STRONGLY ENCOURAGE you to perform with a reduced set.*

The names of the people in your group so that we can make name tags.

REMINDER

Submitting an application does not guarantee you a performance slot. You will receive confirmation of a showcase performance slot on or before October 19th. *If you are not selected to perform and choose not to attend as an exhibitor, you will be given a full refund.*
